## Accessing The Feral Pack Community

The Feral Pack is hosted on **Skool**, a platform designed specifically for engaged communities like ours. Skool combines discussion forums, exclusive content, and direct access to Sean Liscom in one streamlined platform.

### Step 1: Check Your Email

Within 5 minutes of joining The Feral Pack, you'll receive an email with the subject line: **“Welcome to The Feral Pack - Your Community Access Link”**

This email contains your personal invitation link to join the Skool community. The link is unique to you and can only be used once.

**Important:** Check your spam/junk folder if you don't see the email within 10 minutes. Add [noreply@theferalpack.com](mailto:noreply@theferalpack.com) to your contacts to ensure future emails reach your inbox.

## Step 2: Create Your Skool Account

Click the invitation link in your email. You'll be taken to Skool's signup page where you'll create your account:

1. **Choose a username** - This is how other members will see you in the community. Many members use their first name or a survival-themed handle.
2. **Set a strong password** - Protect your account with a unique password you don't use elsewhere.
3. **Add a profile photo** (optional but recommended) - A photo helps build community and makes discussions more personal. It doesn't have to be your face—many members use tactical gear, book covers, or survival-themed images.
4. **Complete your profile** - Tell the community a bit about yourself: Which Sean Liscom books you've read, what drew you to the series, your interests in survival/prepping, etc.

## Step 3: Introduce Yourself

Once you're in, head to the "**New Member Introductions**" section and make your first post. Tell us:

- Your name (or what you'd like to be called)
- Which Sean Liscom series you've read (The Ranch, Feral Outbreak, or both)
- What you're most excited about in the community
- One survival skill you're working on or interested in learning

The community is friendly and welcoming. Don't be shy—everyone was new once, and we're all here because we share a passion for Sean's work and the themes of survival, preparedness, and resilience.
